Paragraph 5.41

Before any development on "Greenfield" land serious and urgent consideration should be given to renovating the significant number of empty dwellings in the town. (A detailed list can be provided when required). Second on the list of priorities is the development of several "Brown field" sites, particularly the most unsightly site in the High Street.

Then, and only then should agricultural land be considered, bearing in mind it's current contribution to home grown food.

Reference is made to previous plans for the town centre not having been fulfilled. These plans should be re-visited and an investigation conducted in the reasons for their incompleteness.
