A) no wind turbines within 2 miles of a house or infringement of green belt
 B) No more Waste burning incinerators (as ones proposed for Kellingley, Ferrybridge) to be allowed. These are often called CHP plants. G) Oversee traffic problems within SDC. A nightmare scenario has been created by putting a roundabout at the end of Low St Brotherton to benefit Ferrybridge. This must be removed, but SDC needs involvement to ensure it does not happen elsewhere.

H) Help to highlight roads which need repairing.
