I think it's important to consider the impact of extra traffic going through Tadcaster. A large development of houses on the York side of Tadcaster will mean a lot of unnecessary traffic going all the way through the town centre and over the bridge on the A659 to get home.

The town was by-passed some years ago to relieve congestion through the town centre. However no provision was made for east bound traffic to exit the A64 on the York side of town. At the moment any traffic heading for the York side of Tadcaster is forced through the centre and over the bridge. The alternative is to stay on the A64 right up to Macdonalds (Redhill Field lane) and then exit and turn back towards the town.

I think that a new exit from the A64 should be considered at the Little Catterton turn off for traffic travelling east. This should ease the traffic through Tadcaster town centre and over the narrow bridge. Motorists living in the Wighill Lane area would also find this more convenient than using the A659 through the town.
