Thank you very much for the answers and information you have provided me with. They clarify matters considerably.

There is only one thing that still puzzles me and this relates to the Local Green Spaces shown on the Policies Map and analysed in Appendix A1. If 'All Saints and the Adjoining Field' consists only of the land within the Conservation Area and the 'Ridge and Furrow Field' is the land adjoining it why are both shown on the Policies Map as Local Green Space when Appendix A1 tell us that the Ridge and Furrow Field is not designated as Local Green Space because it is too extensive? This leads on to a second question, if the 'Ridge and Furrow Field', which is 2ha in extent, is too extensive what is the justification for designating Daffy Field which is also 2ha in extent?

Can I have a response by 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2017 please?
