**Notice of Adoption of The Statement of Community Involvement**

The Statement of Community Involvement defines how and when Selby District Council will engage with stakeholders throughout the planning process. This includes community involvement both through Development Control and Planning Policy functions. The document has now completed all stages of preparation, in line with planning regulations.

Notice is hereby given that:

- On 6 December 2007 Selby District Council formally adopted the Statement of Community Involvement (SCI), in accordance with Regulation 24(4) and Regulation 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004;
- Any person who is aggrieved by the SCI may make an application to the High Court under section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate power or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Such application must be made not later than the end of the period of six weeks starting from 6 December 2007.
- Any person aggrieved by the decision of the Council to adopt its SCI may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the statement. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months from 6 December 2007.
