In terms of our own reps for Barratt please pass on the following:

"The latest projections are recession responsive; do not provide a true reflection of need; and are only estimated to 2021.

As the Council needs to plan to post 2021, and respond to the back log of housing provision caused by the recession (and hence the reason why household formations have decreased, especially in the younger age groups), the most up to date local evidence outlined in a Council's SHMA (where robust) and any local growth aspirations are still the key evidence tools to use in determining future housing numbers."

We would welcome further discussion on this.
