**Selby District Local Development Framework (LDF)
Proposed Changes to the Submission Draft Core Strategy**

The Council is publishing Proposed Changes to the Submission Draft Core Strategy, which will form part of its LDF. The 5th January 2012 marks the start of a period of consultation for 6 weeks to enable representations to be made on the Proposed Changes, prior to submitting the Proposed Changes to the Secretary of State for independent examination.

The Submission Draft of the Core Strategy (May 2011) takes into account views gathered at the previous stages of consultation. The Proposed Changes (January 2012) are now being published in response to matters raised at the EIP which took place in September 2011.

The Council is carrying out a consultation directly with participants on the changes to the Core Strategy arising from its consideration of the three topics specified by the EIP Inspector in accordance with the revised timetable submitted to the examination on 30 September 2011.


