Developer Contributions Supplementary Planning Document

The Developer Contribution Supplementary Planning Document (DCSPD) forms part of the Local Development Framework, which will establish a spatial vision for future development and use of land in the District. The DCSPD amplifies 'saved' policies in the Adopted Selby District Local Plan, which constitutes the basis for seeking contributions from developers of land and buildings in order to lessen the impact of carrying out new development. The SPD applies to the whole of the Selby District administrative area.

Notice is hereby given that:

- a) on 29 March 2007 Selby District Council adopted the Developer Contributions Supplementary Planning Document (SPD);
- b) any person aggrieved by the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SPD; and
- c) any such application for leave must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date (29 March 2007) on which the SPD was adopted.
